Event Information

1. All entries must be entered via BROE and paid via BROE or by cheque to the address above.
2. The Regatta is held under the Rules of British Rowing and the British Rowing Rules of Racing, and Row Safe, apply.
3. All competitors must comply with the rules of the Masters Championships.
4. All competitors must be members of British Rowing (or equivalent for non-BR competitors).
5. British Rowing Racing Licences (or equivalent for non-BR competitors) may be checked on the day.
6. The Masters Handicap System will be used, where appropriate, as detailed in the current British Rowing Almanack.
7. Further details (including the relevant rules) can be found on www.masterschamps.org.
8. Silver medals will be awarded if (at the time the draw is made) there are 4 or more entries in an event and bronze medals if there are 6 or more entries.
9. Racing will start no earlier than 09:00 on each day.
10. Each crew member and each boat may only be entered once in each division.
11. Novice events will be rowed in the same division as the respective Championship event.
12. Open and women's events will be rowed in the same division.
